1 At the end of part IV of subtitle A of title III, add
2 the following:

3 **SEC. 3018. REPEAL OF RENEWABLE FUEL STANDARD.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 211 of the Clean Air Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 7545) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (d)—

7 (A) in paragraphs (1) and (2), by striking
8 “(n), or (o)” each place it appears and insert-
9 ing “or (n)”; and

10 (B) in paragraph (1), in the second sen-
11 tence, by striking “(m), or (o)” and inserting
12 “or (m)”;

(2) by striking subsection (o); and

1 (3) by redesignating subsections (q) through (v)
2 as subsections (o) through (t), respectively.

3 (b) **ADDITIONAL REPEAL.**—Section 204 of the En-
4 ergy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C.
5 7545 note; Public Law 110–140) is repealed.

6 (c) **REGULATIONS.**—Effective beginning on the date
7 of enactment of this Act, the regulations contained in sub-
8 parts K and M of part 80 of title 40, Code of Federal
9 Regulations (as in effect on that date of enactment), shall
10 have no force or effect.
